Course content includes everyday inspection procedures and safety protocol. Trainees learn the way to maneuver in a populated work environment.

When operated by an inexperienced individual, a lift truck could be really dangerous. In order to reduce the risk of accident, prospective operators should go through forklift training by a skilled instructor before using a forklift. All parts of lift truck handling are included in training programs. The limits and abilities of the equipment are covered, together with necessary operating measures, pre-operation inspections and ways of warning other workers that a forklift is in the work area.

Lessons comprise the placement of the trailer tires and chock blocks, the arrangement of pallets in order to spread out the load right, and inspections needed prior to driving into a trailer at a dock location. Courses also comprise Material Safety Data Sheet (or MSDS) training. Though not related directly to the use of a lift truck, MSDS training is important if an operator notices a leaking container or damages a container containing toxic materials. MSDS sheets list the products, their effects on individuals and correct ways of handling spills.
